

Pursuant to Act 1, the Pennsylvania Department of Education publishes an index applicable to the Twin Valley School District. The School District real estate tax increase for the next fiscal year is limited to the index unless the proposed tax rate is approved by voters pursuant to a referendum or the Twin Valley School District qualifies for an Act 1 exception. As a result of special circumstances covered by an Act 1 referendum exception, a tax rate increase above the index may be required to balance the Twin Valley School District budget for the next fiscal year. This tax increase is required to provide a quality education program as reflected in the Twin Valley School District Preliminary Budget.

The Twin Valley School District intends to seek approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Education as required by an Act 1 for an exception allowing increase of the real estate tax as reflected in the Twin Valley School District Preliminary Budget. The Preliminary Budget is available for public inspection in each school building and the Business Office, 4851 N. Twin Valley Road, Elverson, PA. By request of any Twin Valley resident or tax payer, the District will provide a copy of the referendum exception application.

A copy of the proposed budget is also available for review at the Village Library in Morgantown, and the Honey Brook Community Library.
