

Daycare Transportation

Per Twin Valley School District Policy #810, a student may be transported to and from a daycare center/ babysitter, rather than his/her own home. However, the student's babysitter must reside within the same school attendance area in which the child is enrolled. The sitter must live on an existing bus route, since no stops will be established outside of the attendance area or outside of school district boundaries.

Arrangements for stops at a babysitter location shall be the same Monday through Friday. The school may assign children to different buses for the morning pick up and the afternoon return trip, however, as stated above, this must be consistent Monday through Friday. These arrangements carry over from one school year to the next unless the district is otherwise notified.

Please note that the law prohibits a bus driver from changing bus stops without the approval of the school district administration.

School Bus Loading Zones



Recognizing our drivers!

As required by Section 3345 (h) of the Vehicle Code, Title 75 of the

Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, every school district transporting school children by school bus must establish and maintain school bus loading zones at or near all schools to or from which children are transported. Each school district transporting children by school bus also must establish school bus loading zones along the highways traveled by school buses, in accordance with the Department's regulations, Title 67, Chapter 104 of the Pennsylvania Code.

It is unlawful for a school bus operator to stop the bus to pick up or discharge school children at any location other than loading zones. A list of approved loading zones for the route of the school bus must be carried by the operator.

How to Change a Stop

The safe transportation of all students is of utmost concern to the Twin Valley School District. In the past, parents have requested that bus drivers relocate various bus stops. The motor vehicle code regarding school bus loading zones, prohibits a bus driver from changing bus stops without the approval of the school district administration.

To make the district aware of your concerns regarding the location of bus stops, we ask that you notify your child's school or the Transportation Department by telephone or in writing of any changes you request for a bus stop. You will be notified of the approval or non-approval of your request.
