

CAFETERIA UPDATES FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) COVID-19 universal free meal waiver that Twin Valley School District has been operating under has expired as of July 1, 2022. This program was not renewed for the 2022-2023 school year. Students will be charged for meals beginning on the first day of school.

If you anticipate difficulty paying for your child's meals and would like to apply for the free/reduced meal program, an application can be completed at <u>www.schoolcafe.com</u> or <u>www.tvsd.org</u> on the Food Services tab. Your student's enrollment in this program is confidential, and they can feel confident using the program's benefits without other children knowing.

If your family qualifies for SNAP or Medicaid benefits, a notification will be sent by the Food Service Department confirming your child's free meal benefit. If you receive this notification, you WILL NOT need to complete an application.
